Fukuoka Special Corona Alert

 Issued 

On July 22, we, the Prefectural Government, issued the Fukuoka Special Corona Alert.

The number of new cases on July 21 marked 10,752, surpassing 10 thousand cases for the first time. On July 22, the number increased further to 12,155.

The infection has been spreading throughout the prefecture again.

Since July 6, when we issued the Fukuoka Corona Alert, we have asked you, prefectural residents and businesses, to thoroughly implement infection prevention measures.

However, given the spread of infection, we must take more thoroughgoing infection prevention measures and keep the medical system. That is why we issued the Fukuoka Special Corona Alert on July 22, based on expert opinions and consultations with municipalities.

However, at this time, we do not ask you for any regulation such as refraining from traveling and limited business hour.

Request to Prefectural Residents

Ensure basic infection prevention measures

- Avoidance of three-Cs
- Proper wearing of masks
- Hand hygienic practices
- Ventilation etc.



We ask once again that all people, including those who have been vaccinated, take thoroughgoing basic infection prevention measures such as avoiding the three C's, hand washing and other hand hygiene, wearing masks and other hand hygiene, and ventilation.

Adequate **ventilation!**

Keep **regular ventilation**
even while using an **air conditioner!**



We especially ask you to keep adequate ventilation even while using an air conditioner in order to prevent the virus from spreading indoors.

While eating / meeting

- ⚠️ Keep **physical distancing**
- ⚠️ **No speaking loudly**
(No action causing the virus to spread)
- ⚠️ Choose restaurants with **infection prevention certification**

In case you eat with others or attend a meeting, we ask you to keep physical distancing and refrain from action such as speaking loudly which can cause the virus to spread. When dining

out, please choose restaurants that have thorough infection prevention measures in place, including restaurants with infection prevention certification.

If you have symptoms such as FEVER or malaise

- ✓ **Refrain from going out**
- ✓ **Seek medical attention**



If you have symptoms such as fever or malaise, please avoid going out and seek medical attention.

Asymptomatic persons who are concerned about being infected

Free PCR and other tests

Available at 569 locations in the prefecture



Those who are concerned about infection or plan to meet your parents or relatives, travel or eat with your friends, etc., are encouraged to take advantage of the free testing currently available at 569 locations throughout the prefecture.

When meeting the elderly or those with underlying medical conditions

Take thoroughgoing

Wearing a mask indoors / Adequate ventilation



When meeting the elderly during staying in your hometown, we ask you to take thoroughgoing infection prevention measures, such as wearing a mask indoors and frequent ventilation.

Vaccination

**Those who wish to be vaccinated,
please do as soon as possible!**

Third Vaccination

Fourth Vaccination

(e.g., those over 60 years old, those with
underlying medical conditions, etc.)



We ask that the elderly and others who have been vaccinated five months after the third vaccination consider receiving the fourth vaccination as soon as possible. We also recommend that those who have not yet received the third dose of the vaccine also consider receiving it as soon as possible.
